GENERAL INFORMATION

Access To Company Equipment

Equipment, instruments, and lines furnished by Gridley Telephone Co. on the premises of a subscriber are the property of Gridley Telephone Co., whose agents and employees shall have the right to enter said premises at any reasonable hour for the purpose of installing, inspecting, maintaining or repairing the equipment, instruments, and lines, or for the purpose of making collections from coin boxes, or upon termination of service, for the purpose of removing such equipment, instruments, and lines.

Customer-Provided Equipment And Wiring Customer-provided equipment may be connected to Gridley Telephone Co. facilities if it is registered or otherwise approved through the FCC and meets the conditions set forth in the Gridley Exchange Tariff. Attachments to the wiring network are to be made in conjunction with the ICC Standards for Customer- Provided Inside Wiring. A maintenance or service charge may be incurred if Gridley Telephone Co. personnel visit the premises of the customer, and the service difficulty or trouble is found to have been caused by customer provided equipment or wiring. These rules and tariffs are designed to meet the convenience of the customer and at the same time protect the telephone network against any possible hazards to customers and company employees. If you have any questions concerning the use of customer-provided equipment or wiring, please contact the Gridley Telephone Co.

Use Of Subscriber Service

Subscriber telephone service, as distinguished from public and semi-public telephone service, is furnished only for use by the subscriber, his family, employees or business associates, or persons residing in the subscriber's household, except as the use of the service may be extended to joint users or to persons temporarily subleasing a subscriber's residential premises. The Gridley Telephone Co. has the right to refuse to install subscriber service or to permit such service to remain on premises of a public or semi-public character when the instrument is so located that the public in general or patrons of the subscriber may make use of the service. At such locations, however, subscriber service may be installed, provided the instrument is so located that it is not accessible for public use.

Tampering With Equipment

The Gridley Telephone Co. may refuse to furnish or may deny telephone service to any person, firm or corporation on whose premises is located any telephone equipment which shows any evidence of tampering, manipulation, or operation, or use of any device whatsoever, for the purpose of obtaining telephone service without payment of charges applicable to the service rendered.

Telephone Directories

Every effort is made to avoid any errors in this directory, but Gridley Telephone Co. cannot and does not assume any liability for damages arising from errors or omissions in the making of or posting its directories. If an error is found in your listing, please notify us promptly so that the listing may be corrected in the next issue.

Payment Of Bills

Bills for service are rendered monthly. Local service is billed in advance and toll service is billed in arrears. You are required to pay all charges for exchange service and equipment, and for all toll messages in accordance with provisions contained in the Gridley Exchange Tariff. You are held responsible for all charges for telephone service rendered at this telephone, both local and toll, including charges for toll messages on which charges have been reversed. Bills rendered are due and payable as indicated on the statement. E-mail billing is also available upon request. Telephone bills may be paid in person, by mail, bank draft or credit card. View and pay your bill online at www.gridtel.com. Call 309-747-2221 for more details. An outside drop box is also available for your convenience. Any bill remaining unpaid on the due date will be assessed a late fee of 1.5% of the unpaid balance. You will be subject to notice of non-payment prior to disconnection of the service.

If You Can't Pay On Time

If you are unable to pay your bill on time, please call a Gridley Telephone Co. Customer Service Representative at 309-747-2221. Late payments will impair your credit standing with us. Repeated late payments may result in disconnection.

Toll Blocking Service

Toll Blocking Service is offered to all subscribers and is free upon request. Toll Blocking Service allows subscribers to call local (309) 747 numbers, operator services, 911 or E-911 emergency services, and 800/844/855/866/877/888 toll free services.

900 Service Blocking, International Toll Blocking, and Collect Call Blocking are also available to all subscribers. Contact the Gridley Telephone Co. office for details.

Customer Billing Rights For 900 Number Calls

Gridley Telephone Co. provides billing services for long-distance companies and companies offering 900 number information services. If you have a 900 billing dispute or inquiry, please call the Gridley Telephone Co. business office at 309-747-2221.

You have 60 days from the date of the bill to dispute a 900 billing error. You have the right to withhold payment of the disputed 900 charges during the billing error review. No collection activity for disputed 900 charges will occur while the charges are under investigation. After investigation, if it is determined that the disputed 900 charges are legitimate, the 900 information provider may proceed with outside collections against your account for non-payment of these charges.

Your local and long distance services cannot be disconnected for non-payment of 900 charges. Failure to pay legitimate 900 charges may result in involuntary blocking of your access to 900 services. Voluntary blocking of access to 900 service is available upon request from Gridley Telephone Co.

Obscene And Harassing Calls

WARNING: Illinois law defines harassment by telephone as the use of telephone communications for any of the following purposes:

- making any lewd or indecent comment or request with intent to offend;
- making one or more repeated telephone calls (whether or not conversation occurs) with intent to abuse, threaten or harass;
- causing the telephone of another to ring repeatedly with intent to harass;
- knowingly allowing any telephone under one's control to be used for any of the above.

Telephone Safety

The telephone is one of the safest appliances in your home or office, but there are a few situations where a telephone user should be cautious.

- Do NOT use the telephone while you are in the bathtub, shower or swimming pool. Putting the telephone in water could cause electrical shock.
- Do NOT use the telephone during an electrical storm in your immediate area. Urgent calls should be brief. Although the telephone company uses protective measures to limit abnormal electrical surges from entering your home, absolute protection from lightning is impossible.
- Do NOT use the telephone to report a gas leak. The telephone contains electrical contacts that could generate a tiny spark when you lift the handset. While unlikely, this spark could trigger an explosion.

Customer Service

We hope it won't happen, but if you have a complaint about your telephone service, please discuss the problem with a Gridley Telephone Co. Customer Service Representative. If the Customer Service Representative cannot solve your problem, ask to speak with a manager.

If you feel your dispute is still not resolved, you may contact the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) for further review of your complaint or dispute. To reach the commission, you may call 1-800-524-0795.

You may also write to the Illinois Commerce Commission, Consumer Services Division, State of Illinois Building, 160 N. LaSalle St., Suite C800, Chicago, IL 60601-3104 or 527 E. Capitol Ave., Springfield, IL 62794.

Upon receipt of your complaint, the Consumer Service Division will review and investigate your concern and will advise you of their findings. If the Consumer Services Division is unable to resolve the complaint, you may file a formal complaint with the ICC.

Illinois Relay Service (711)

Illinois local telephone companies provide a service that allows people with hearing or speech disabilities to place and receive calls using Text Telephone (TTY), to communicate using a standard telephone. The service is available seven days a week, 24 hours a day. The relay operator speaks to the standard telephone user and types to the TTY user. There is no cost for the use of this service. Relay service should not be used in emergencies; callers should use their local 9-1-1 or local emergency access numbers.

The relay service, which is required by state and federal law, is funded by a small fee included in your monthly service charge. The program is administered by the Illinois Telecommunications Access Corporation (ITAC) on behalf of all local telephone companies in Illinois. For more information about relay service, call ITAC at 1-800-841-6167 v/tty. To use the Illinois Relay Service call 711.

Price Disclosure Required For Away - From - Home Calls

In response to consumer complaints filed against Operator Service Providers (OSPs), the FCC issued an order requiring long distance carriers providing service at public phones to inform customers orally of their right to obtain rate quotations before carriers may connect and charge for calls. Consumers will be able to find out all prices for a phone call, including any surcharges, by pressing a button, such as the # key, or staying on the line.

The order requires OSPs to notify customers of the price of their service, allowing consumers to decide not to place a call or to dial around to the carrier of their choice. The order applies to all OSP calls made from payphones and other locations, such as hotels, hospitals, airports, and educational institutions where callers dial 0+ the number. All public phones had to comply with the order by July 1, 1998, with a limited exception for certain phones that first had to be modified or replaced.

Financial Assistance Available

The Lifeline Service Program (Lifeline), sponsored by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) is a program designed to maintain and preserve universal service by providing a reduction in the price of basic residential exchange service (voice) or broadband internet service to qualifying low-income customers. Lifeline service assistance provides eligible consumers a monthly credit.

Eligibility:

For a consumer to be eligible under the income requirements, the consumer's household income as defined in the FCC Rules must be at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines for a household of that size or be a recipient of benefits from any one of the following federal programs:

- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Medicaid
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Veterans Pension or Survivors Pension

An eligible consumer may receive a discount on either a wireline or wireless service, but not on both.

You may elect to participate in the funding of the UTSAP by electing to contribute, monthly, a fixed amount to be included in your telephone bill until you choose to cancel.

Buried Cable Information

What Is JULIE?

JULIE is a not-for-profit corporation that helps homeowners and excavators find buried utility facilities with one toll-free number: 1-800-892-0123 or call 811.

When To Call JULIE:

Whether you're planting trees, installing a fence or deck, putting up a basketball hoop, or a swing set for the kids, Illinois law requires all homeowners to call JULIE before digging.

Illinois law requires any person digging to call JULIE 48 hours in advance allowing the utility companies time to mark their buried facilities. The 48 hours' notice does not include Saturdays, Sundays, or holidays. If you dig before the 48 hours has passed you may assume additional liability.

Illinois Restricted Call Registry

Illinois law protects residents from certain unwanted telemarketing calls. For more information about the Restricted Call Registry and how to enroll visit the Illinois Commerce Commission web site at www.icc.illinois.gov. The National Do Not Call Registry is open for business, putting consumers in charge of the telemarketing calls they get at home. The Federal government created the national registry to make it easier and more efficient for you to stop getting telemarketing calls you don't want. You can register online at www.donotcall.gov or call toll-free, 1-888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236), from the number you wish to register. Registration is free.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Local Exchange Service Quality Requirements*

Subject to certain exclusions and limitations, any telephone company providing local exchange service in Illinois is required to:

- Install basic local exchange service within 5 business days after receipt of a complete order from a customer or 3 business days after the provisioning of the line by the carrier whose network or network elements are being utilized by your local exchange company or by a customer-requested later date. If a customer requests an installation date that is beyond 5 business days, service must be installed by the customer requested date.
- Restore basic local exchange service within 24 hours of receiving proper notice that a customer's telephone service is out-of-service.
- Keep all repair and installation appointments for basic local exchange service when the company informs the customer that a premise visit requires the customer to be present for the appointment, unless the telephone company provides 24 hours' notice of its inability to keep the appointment.

If the telephone company fails to achieve these requirements, you may be eligible for a credit or other relief. The telephone company will automatically calculate any appropriate credit and apply it to your next bill.

Customers may not be entitled to a credit when: (1) an emergency situation arises, (2) a customer's willful or negligent act prevents the company from providing service, (3) a customer's inside wiring or telephone equipment malfunctions, (4) the customer misses an appointment or requests a later appointment, (5) the carrier's right to refuse service as provided for in Commission rules, or (6) the carrier lacks facilities at the service location.

For repairs of out of service conditions, the calculation of the automatic credit is based upon the following:

24 – 48 Hours	pro-rata credit
48 – 72 Hours	33% recurring monthly charges
72 – 96 Hours	67% recurring monthly charges
96 – 120 Hours	100% recurring monthly charges
>120 Hours	alternative telephone service or \$20 per day (at the customer's option)

For installation, the calculation of the automatic credit is based on the following: after

5 business days**	50% installation charges (Link Up credit of \$25) after 10
business days**	100% installation charges (Link Up credit of \$50)
> 10 days	100% installation charges (Link Up credit of \$50) and alternative telephone service or \$20 per day (at the customer's option)

If the local exchange telephone company misses an appointment without providing 24-hour notice to the customer, an automatic credit of \$50 will be issued.

If you have any questions about these service quality requirements, you should call your local telephone company's business office.

* The above requirements are based on 83 Illinois Administrative Code 732. They are subject to change by the Illinois Commerce Commission.

** The different scenarios in the first bullet point are applicable in the calculation of the credit.

REPAIR SERVICE

Troubleshooting Instructions

If you have a service problem, Gridley Telephone is available for assistance. However, before you call, please follow these procedures to help identify the problem.

Before You Call

1. Unplug all telephones and other devices such as computer modems, fax machines and answering machines. Plug in each device, one at a time, to determine if your equipment is causing the problem and which one. If your equipment is causing the problem, contact the store where you purchased it or the manufacturer.
2. If you do not think your equipment is causing the problem, then test to determine if the problem is in your telephone service coming up to your house. Go to the network interface device (NID) or optical network terminal (ONT), generally located near your electric meter. The NID or ONT is where the outside line connects to the inside wiring. To test the line coming up to your house, plug a single line phone directly into the modular jack that's enclosed in the NID/ONT.

Test Results

If none of your phones work at the NID/ONT, the problem is probably with the line coming up to your house. If a phone works at the NID/ONT, the problem is probably in your inside wiring or in your equipment.

You will not be charged if the problem is in an outside line, or you have GRIDCOM's Inside Wiring Maintenance Plan and the problem is covered in the Plan. Otherwise, you will be charged labor and materials. Call the Gridley Telephone office for current pricing.

The Network Interface Device (NID)

The network interface device (NID), is where the outside line connects to the inside wiring. The NID is generally located on the side of house near the electric meter. The NID enables the customer to test their telephones and their inside wiring in case of trouble.

The Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

In some of our service areas, Gridley Telephone has deployed fiber to the home (FTTH) networks.

The fiber that services a home can provide telephone and internet services. Locations serviced by FTTH will have equipment that differs from customers serviced by traditional copper cabling. However, the troubleshooting procedures are the same.

REPAIR SERVICE

How to Use Your NID/ONT

Open the NID/ONT

1. Loosen the screw holding the enclosure together.
2. Remove the cover.

Test your equipment

1. Disconnect the inside wiring plug from the jack.
2. Connect the plug of a telephone directly into the jack.
3. If the telephone operates properly, the trouble is with the inside wiring or with another telephone.
4. If the telephone does not operate properly, try another telephone.
5. If that does not work the problem is probably with the outside line. Reconnect the inside wiring plug to the jack.
6. Contact Gridley Telephone Co. repair service to report the problem.

Close the NID/ONT

1. Either swing the door closed or slide the cover all the way down.
2. Tighten the screw.

Emergency Repair Service

If your phone service is dead during the evening or weekend, you may call our Emergency Repair Service at 309-747-3288 to reach our on-call employee. Please follow the Troubleshooting Instructions before you call, then report the test results to the on-call employee or message recorder.

VOICE MAIL SERVICE

Voice Mail is a reliable, easy-to-use answering system that takes messages when you are away from your phone and when you're on another call.

Voice Mail \$4.95

Set-up Instructions for Voice Mail

Step A - Activate Call Forward No Answer

This step activates the Call Forward Don't Answer feature that sends incoming calls to your mailbox whenever you do not answer a call. You will set the number of times your telephone rings before Voice Mail is activated. We suggest you set the number of rings to 4 or 5. This will allow you the option to answer your call before it is sent to your VoiceMail mailbox.

1. Lift handset and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial *92
3. Again, listen for dial tone.
4. Dial a number between 2 and 9 to indicate the number of times you want your phone to ring before Voice Mail answers your calls.
5. Dial 309-747-8800 to route your calls to the Voice Mail service. After Voice Mail answers, hang up the phone. All incoming calls will be sent to your mailbox after the specified number of rings.

Step B - Activate Call Forward Busy

This step activates the Call Forward Busy feature that sends your calls to your mailbox whenever your line is busy.

1. Lift handset and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial *90
3. Again, listen for dial tone. Do not hang up.
4. Dial 309-747-8800. After VoiceMail has answered your call, hang up.

To Set-up Your Mailbox

Mailbox Set-up Menu

Dial 309-747-8800. Wait until you hear Main Menu and then Press 9.

Press 1: Greeting options. (Disregard if you choose to use the default greeting.)

Press 2: Change password.

Press 3: Notification Options. (Optional feature)

Press 4: Disable/Enable Auto-Login.

Press *: Return to main menu.

To Change or Record Your Greeting

Dial 309-747-8800. Wait until you hear Main Menu and then Press 9.

Press 1: Greeting options.

Press 2: Record your greeting. Press #: End recording function.

Press 1: Listen to greeting.

To Create Multiple Greetings

Dial 309-747-8800. Wait until you hear Main Menu and then Press 9.

Press 5: Pick a new greeting. Then choose a new greeting # (2-9).

Press 2: Record greeting.

Press #: End recording function. Repeat the first two steps, choosing a different greeting # each time.

Press 5: Pick a new greeting. Then choose the greeting you wish to become active.

Press 1: Play or re-play message.

Press 2: Save message and go to next.

Undelete Messages

Don't hang up. Follow the voice prompts to listen to the messages. Once you have played the message you deleted,

Press 4: Save message as new.

Press 5: Reply to the message. (Optional feature)

Press 6: Forward a message. (Optional feature)

Press 7: Skip back three seconds.

Press 8: Pause or continue message.

Press 9: Skip forward three seconds.

Press *: Return to main menu.

To Change Your Password

Press 2: Change your password.

Enter new password, followed by the # key. The password is any series of up to 16 digits you choose. You will be unable to access your mailbox without this password, so be sure to choose one you remember. To verify, enter your password, followed by the # key.

Your Voice Mail is now ready.

We suggest you make two test calls.

1. Have someone call your line, and Voice Mail will answer the call after the number of rings you selected in Step A.
2. Have someone call your telephone number while it is busy, and Voice Mail will answer the call immediately.

Accessing Your Mailbox

1. *From your home:* If you have new messages in your mailbox, you will hear a stuttered dial tone when you pick up your handset. Dial 1-309-747-8800 and follow the prompts.
2. *From a location in the Gridley exchange that also has Voice Mail:* Dial 1-309-747-8800, when Voice Mail answers, press *. Then follow instructions to enter your mailbox number (your phone number) followed by the # key and your password followed by the # key.
3. *From a location in the Gridley exchange that does not have Voice Mail:* Dial 1-309-747-8800, when Voice Mail answers, follow instructions to enter your phone number followed by the # key and password followed by the # key.
4. *From a location outside the Gridley exchange:* Dial 1-309-747-8800, when Voice Mail answers, follow instructions to enter your phone number followed by the # key and password followed by the # key.

Accessing Your Sub-Mailbox

1. Follow Step 1, 2, 3, or 4 from above.
2. a. If you are the Group Administrator and wish to record a group greeting, Press * to access the Group Greeting Menu. A voice prompt will guide you through those steps.
OR
b. Enter your sub-mailbox number.
3. If requested, enter your password, followed by the # key. Your password will default to your 7 digit phone number until you change it.
4. Main menu: Press 1 to retrieve messages, Press 5 to hear which sub-mailboxes have new messages, or Press 9 for mailbox setup.

To Deactivate Voice Mail From Answering Your Calls When You Don't Answer:

1. Lift the handset and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial *93.
3. Listen for 2 beeps, hang up.

To Deactivate Voice Mail From Answering Your Calls When Your Line is Busy:

1. Lift the handset and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial *91.
3. Listen for 2 beeps, hang up.

Anonymous Call Rejection - \$3.00

Allows subscribers to reject calls for which calling name or calling number display information has been intentionally blocked by the calling party.

Automatic Call Back - \$2.00

Allows subscribers to automatically redial their last outgoing call, whether the call was answered, unanswered or busy.

Automatic Recall - \$2.00

Allows subscribers to automatically dial the telephone number of the last incoming call, whether the call was answered or unanswered.

Calling Waiting - \$1.00

Alerts subscriber to incoming call when on the phone.

Calling Name and Number Delivery - \$5.00 Transmits the name and number associated with the telephone number of the incoming call to the subscriber's equipment. The name and number are displayed after the first ring.

Call Waiting ID - \$2.00

Allows subscribers to see who is trying to call while on the phone. A special tone announces the call. The name and number of the incoming call is displayed on the Caller ID display screen. Call Waiting and Caller ID are required for this feature.

Customer Originated Trace - \$6.00

Allows a trace on the last incoming call by dialing an activation code. The calling party's number is sent to a printer in the telephone office. The proper law enforcement agency will determine further action.

Distinctive Ringing/Call Waiting - \$2.00

Allows subscribers to define a list of telephone numbers that will provide a unique ringing pattern or distinctive call waiting tone whenever an incoming call is from a number on the list.

Per Call Name and Number Blocking - FREE Allows the calling party to dial a code prior to each call attempt that will prevent their name and number from appearing on the call display unit of the person receiving the call. This service is provided on all lines at no charge.

Per Line Name and Number Blocking - \$3.00 Allows the calling party to prevent their name and number from appearing on the call display unit of the person receiving the call. The subscriber can turn this feature on and off at their discretion.

Selective Call Acceptance - \$3.00

Allows subscribers to define a list of telephone numbers that will be accepted by the subscriber. Any calls from a number not on the list will be sent to a recorded message and rejected.

Selective Call Forwarding - \$3.00

Allows subscribers to define a list of telephone numbers so that only terminating calls from those locations are forwarded to another telephone number.

Selective Call Rejection - \$3.00

Allows subscribers to define a list of telephone numbers to be screened. Calls received from those locations are sent to a recorded message and rejected. Any calls from a number not on the list will be accepted.

CALLING FEATURES – HOW TO USE

Call Forwarding & Remote Access With PIN

To Activate Call Forwarding From Your Telephone:

1. Lift the receiver and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial "72"
3. Depress the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.
4. Again, listen for dial tone.
5. Dial the number where you wish your calls forwarded.
6. If someone answers at the forwarded number, Call Forwarding is put into effect.
7. If there is no answer, or the line is busy, hang up and repeat each step within two minutes.

You'll hear two beeps when your Call Forwarding feature becomes effective. Once you've activated Call Forwarding, the phone will make one short ring each time a call is forwarded, but you will be unable to answer. However, you can still make out-going calls from this phone.

To Discontinue Call Forwarding:

1. Lift the receiver and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial "73"
3. Depress the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.
You'll hear two beeps when your Call Forwarding feature is discontinued.

To Activate Call Forwarding From Another Telephone:

1. Dial (309) 747-9988, wait for response tone.
2. Dial your 10-digit telephone number plus your 4-digit PIN number, wait for a tone.
3. Dial "72"
4. Depress the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.
5. Again, listen for dial tone.
6. Dial the number where you wish your calls forwarded.
You'll hear two beeps when your Call Forwarding feature becomes effective.

To Discontinue Call Forwarding From Another Telephone:

1. Dial (309) 747-9988, wait for response tone.
2. Dial your 10-digit telephone number plus your 4-digit PIN number, wait for tone.
3. Dial "73"
4. Depress the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.
You'll hear two beeps when your Call Forwarding feature is discontinued.

CALLING FEATURES – HOW TO USE

Call Forward Busy

To Activate Call Forward Busy:

1. Lift the handset and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial *90
3. Again, listen for dial tone. (Don't hang up).
4. Dial the phone number you want your calls forwarded to.
5. If there is no answer at the other end, repeat the process.

To Deactivate Call Forward Busy:

1. Lift the handset and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial *91
3. Listen for 2 beeps, hang up.

Call Forward No Answer

To Activate Call Forward No Answer:

1. Lift the handset and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial *92
3. Again, listen for dial tone.
4. Dial a number between 2 and 9 to indicate the number of times you want your phone to ring before your calls are forwarded. (Don't hang up).
5. Dial the phone number you want your calls forwarded to.

To Deactivate Call Forward No Answer:

1. Lift the handset and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial *93
3. Listen for 2 beeps, hang up.

Call Waiting & Cancel Call Waiting

How Call Waiting Alerts You:

1. A beep tone signals you when another caller is trying to reach you. Only you hear the tone.
2. Another reminder tone will be heard ten seconds later if the waiting call remains unanswered.
3. The second caller hears the normal ringing sounds only.

How To Answer The Second Call:

1. Depress the hookswitch for about one second to place your first call on hold.
2. You will automatically be connected with the second caller.

How To Alternate Between Calls:

1. By depressing the hookswitch for about one second, you may alternate between calls.
2. Each conversation is private and cannot be heard by the other caller.

To Terminate Either Call:

1. Simply hang up on the conversation you wish to end.
2. Wait for your phone to ring.
3. When you answer, you'll be connected to the other party.

To Activate Cancel Call Waiting:

1. Lift the receiver and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial "70"
3. Depress the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.
4. Listen for confirmation tone.
5. Place your call.

The call waiting feature will automatically resume on your next telephone call.

CALLING FEATURES – HOW TO USE

Speed Calling 8

How To Establish Your Speed Calling List:

1. Lift the receiver and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial "74"
3. Depress the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.
4. Again, listen for dial tone.
5. Dial one of the 8 one-digit access code numbers (2-9).
6. Dial the number you wish to Speed Code.
7. Depress the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.
8. Listen for the confirmation tone to indicate your Speed Calling number is established.
Repeat this process for each number you wish to Speed Code, assigning each a different code number.

How To Use Your Speed Calling Feature:

1. Lift the receiver and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial the appropriate one-digit access number (2-9).
3. Push the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.

How To Change Your Speed Calling List:

1. Follow the same steps to establish your list. The new number replaces the existing number.

Speed Calling 30

How To Establish Your Speed Calling List:

1. Lift the receiver and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial "75"
3. Depress the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.
4. Again, listen for dial tone.
5. Dial one of the 30 two-digit access code numbers (20-49).
6. Dial the number you wish to Speed Code.
7. Depress the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.
8. Listen for the confirmation tone to indicate your Speed Calling number is established.
Repeat this process for each number you wish to Speed Code, assigning each a different code number.

How To Use Your Speed Calling Feature:

1. Lift the receiver and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial the appropriate two-digit access number (20-49).
3. Push the "#" key or allow a 4-second pause.

How To Change Your Speed Calling List:

1. Follow the same steps to establish your list. The new number replaces the existing number.

Three-Way Calling

How To Add A Third Party:

1. First, hold your existing call by depressing the hookswitch for one second.
2. Dial the third number. When the third-party answers, you may talk privately before completing your connection.
3. With your third party on the line, depress the hookswitch for one second to add the holding party. If your call to the third party is busy or not completed, depress the hookswitch twice to get back to your held party.

To Disconnect The Third Party:

1. Depress the hookswitch for one second. You will now have only the original party on the line. If either of the parties hangs up, you may continue to talk to the other.

To Disconnect Completely:

1. Hang up.

Distinctive Ring (Teen Line)

How Distinctive Ring Works:

1. The telephone company programs a second telephone number to ring on your existing telephone line.
2. When the second number is dialed your telephone will ring twice in the time span of one normal ring.
3. Distinctive Ring is useful in homes where teenagers receive calls that the parents do not want to answer, or for anyone who wants to have two telephone numbers and pay for only one local service.

Ring Again

To Activate Ring Again:

1. If you receive a busy signal on a local call, depress the hook switch for one second.
2. Dial *63 then hang up.
3. Your telephone will ring as soon as the person you are calling hangs up. When you pick up the handset, the other person's phone will ring.

To Deactivate Ring Again:

1. Dial *64 to deactivate Ring Again immediately.
2. The feature will automatically stop in 30 minutes or if no one answers during the ring back attempt.

LONG DISTANCE - HOW TO DIAL LONG DISTANCE CALLS

Direct Dial Calls

1. Dial "1", then dial the Area Code.
2. Dial the telephone number you want to reach.

Collect Calls

1. Dial "0", then dial the Area Code.
2. Dial the telephone number you want to reach.
3. When the operator comes on the line, say you are placing a Collect Call and give your name. The operator will leave the line when the person you are calling agrees to accept the long distance charges.

Directory Assistance

1. Dial "411"

800 Service Calls

1. Dial "1", then "800, 822, 833, 844, 855, 866, 877 or 888" then the 7 digit telephone number.
2. There is no charge to the calling party for these calls.

900 Service Calls

1. Dial "1", then "900," then the telephone number of the 900 Service customer.
2. There is a charge to the calling party for these calls.
3. 900 Service Blockage is available free of charge.

500 Service Calls

1. Dial "1", then "500", then the 7 digit number assigned to the personal communication service number.
2. There is a charge to the calling party for these calls.

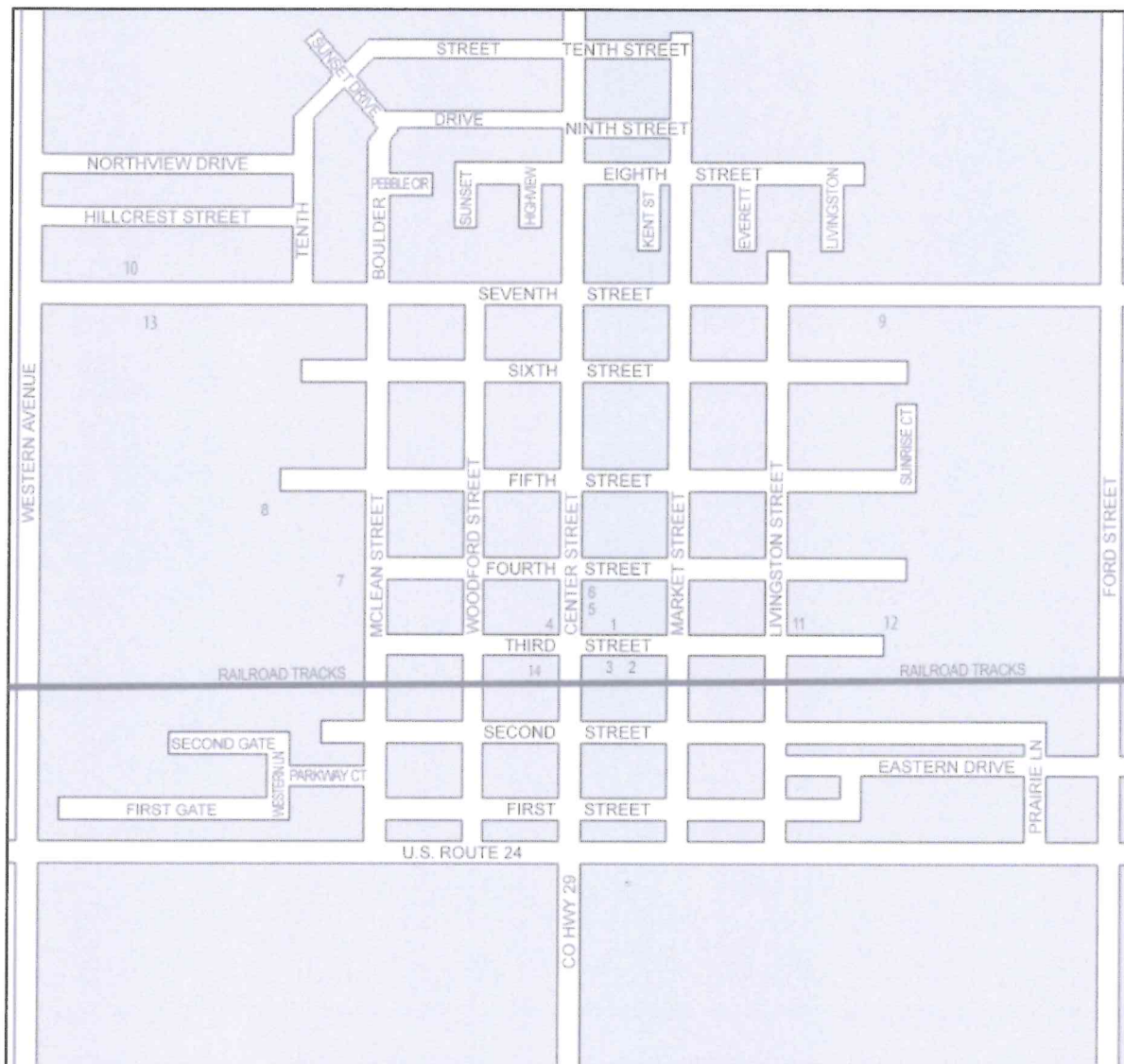
International - Direct Dial Calls

1. Dial "011", then dial the International Country Code.
2. Dial the telephone number you want to reach.

Operator

1. Dial "0" to reach the local operator.
2. Dial "00" to reach your Primary Interexchange Carrier operator.
